1 RULES

1.1 This event is governed by the Racing Rules of sailing.

2 COMMUNICATION

2.1 On the water, channel 68 will be monitored.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** This race is open to all sailboats, and the PHRF handicap system will apply for scoring purposes.
- **3.2** There will be 2 classes or this race, PHRF and JOG(Cruising), with the PHRF class starting first.
- 3.3 Boats may enter the event by signing the sheet in the LMYC Clubhouse, or notifying Race Director Susan Brosseau see 13.1

4 FEES

4.1 There is no fee for this event. Each boat owner is responsible for payment to Scudder Marina for their dockage.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 First warning signal will be at 0955AM with the start at 1000AM for PHRF boats. followed by the JOG starting sequence with an expected JOG start of 1005AM

6 COURSES

- 6.1 The course to be sailed will be as follows SAIL to PELEE Have fun, Be safe. Start will be between Bar Point and Willow Beach at approx 42.02.3802. N x 083.06.785.W. See map on next page.
- The finish line will be between the blue Flag at the end of the cement pier and the break wall.

7 BERTHING

7.1 There are 17 boat slips reserved at Scudder Marina for our event. Once the first 17 have signed up, it is the responsibility of the boat owner to reach out to Scudder Marina (519)724-2377 or scudder@pelee.ca to reserve a spot.

8 PRIZE

8.1 There are 2 trophy's for this event one for PHRF and one for JAM (Cruising). The winner of each division will have their name engraved on these trophies which reside at LMYC. Boats starting from Bar Point will be eligible for this Prize.

9 RISK STATEMENT

9.1 RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate us a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury.
