Saturday September 14, 2019 Sailing Instructions

- 1. **RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the PHRF-LE class rules, and these Sailing Instructions.
- **2. REGISTRATION:** Open registration will take place at Jolly Roger Sailing Club on Friday, September 13, from 1800 2000 hrs. The registration fee must be accompanied by a completed registration form, 2018 PHRF-LE Rating certificate and Proof of Insurance.
- 3. **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the JRSC clubhouse. An attempt will be made to post notices on the window at NCYC but it is not required.
- **4. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Changes to the Sailing Instructions can be made, on the water, communicated to each boat before her warning signal. The Race Committee will hoist Code Flag "L" (come within hail) and notify each boat of the change. The skipper of each boat should acknowledge the communication.
- 5. **SIGNALS MADE ASHORE:** Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located in front of the JRSC clubhouse. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after AP is lowered.
- 6. **SCHEDULE:** September 14 0955 First Warning Signal

For Fall Series racers, subsequent races each day will be held as soon as possible. When all boats in each class have finished another race will be started immediately. As many races as possible will be run. One race constitutes a series.

For Buccaneer racers, there will be a single start for all fleets.

7. **CLASS FLAGS:** Class ID flags and starting order for the first start of the day: Race Committee may also broadcast this information on channel 71 prior to the start of the race.

- 8. **RACING AREAS:** The racing area will be the western basin of Lake Erie. The starting and finishing lines will be located at the Center Mark.
- 9. **COURSE FOR FALL SERIES**: The course to be sailed will be indicated by a number displayed on the stern of the Race Committee boat.

Course Marks All marks are to be rounded to the port in order.

- 1 Start, North Mark, South Mark, Finish
- 2 Start, East Mark, West Mark, Finish
- 3 Start, South Mark, North Mark, Finish
- 4 Start, West Mark, East Mark, Finish

COURSE FOR BUCCANEER RACE:

Course Marks All marks are to rounded as designated in parentheses.

- 5 Start, H(s), I(p), R(p), Finish
- 6 Start, R(s), I(s), H(p), Finish
- 7 Start, H(p), R(p), Finish
- 8 Start, R(s), H(s), Finish
- 10. MARKS FOR FALL SERIES: All rounding marks will be NCYC fixed marks.

MARKS FOR BUCCANEER RACE:

- H TOLEDO HARBOR LIGHT
- I TOLEDO WATER INTAKE CRIB (including all its protective buoys)
- R R-10 Buoy of the Toledo Shipping Channel.
- 11. **START AND FINISH LINES**: The start line will be between an orange flag on the port side of the RC Boat and the Center Mark. The finishing line will be between a blue flag on the starboard side of the RC Boat and an orange ball. The race will be started in accordance with RRS 26. The starting line and finish line are closed. Any boat that violates the closed line rule will be scored DSQ and shall not be granted a hearing for redress.
- 12. **Protest:** Competitors shall notify the Race Committee after finishing of any intent to file a protest. Written protests shall be delivered to the RC within 1 hour after the Race Committee finishing boat docks. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after the hour limit has expired.
- 13. **SCORING**: The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. There will be no "throw outs."
- 14. TROPHIES: Trophies and flags will be awarded Saturday at JRSC after all races have been scored
- 15. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS: The Race Committee will use VHF 71.
